HIGHLIGHTS OF AGRICULTURE ACCOMPLISHMENTS C.Y. 2021

A. RICE BANNER PROGRAMS ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT 2021

The following projects were downloaded from Department of Agriculture – Regional Field Office MIMAROPA thru the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist, Agricultural Programs Coordinating Office, and this office respectively.

I. WET SEASON

• INBRED RICE PROJECT - HIGH YIELDING TECHNOLOGY ADOPTATION (IRP-HYTA) PROGRAM

A total of four hundred (400) bags of rice seeds were distributed to one hundred ninety-nine (199) eligible rice farmer beneficiaries within this municipality. Rice farmer beneficiaries with an area of .6 hectares and above received and enjoyed the above-mentioned assistance.

B. ANIMAL PRODUCTION AND MANAGEMENT

• Native Chicken Multiplier Farm

Native Chicken dispersal to qualified household in support of the Livelihood Project for Covid-19 Response through this office respectively. Each qualified household were given 4 hens and 1 rooster capable for reproduction.









• Mass Vaccination of Dogs

The Office of the Provincial Veterinarian conducted Mass Vaccination of Dogs within the 11 barangay's of this municipality last November 17-24, 2021 and it was assisted by the Office of the Municipal Agriculturist.







• Animal Health Nutrition Program

Regular Animal Health Promotion Program of this office were able to distribute deworming and veterinary medicine to sixteen (16) walk-in by request individuals as shown in the Table below.

III - HIGH VALUE COMMERCIAL CROPS (HVCC)

A) Vegetables Seeds

A.1) Vegetables Seeds from DA Region Office - MIMAROPA

In support of the Federal Food Security Program, through the Department of Agriculture Regional Field Office – MIMAROPA thru the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist, Agricultural Programs Coordinating Office, and this office respectively on its High Value Crops Development Program, our office has distributed 30 kilograms of assorted vegetables seeds to farmers associations, backyard growers, gardeners, schools and community garden representatives (4P's Communal Garden). There were 335 farmer beneficiaries of vegetables seeds benefited the program. (Kindly refer to Table 1).

C. Garden Tools and Equipment

D. Philippine Crop Insurance Corporation (PCIC) Claim for Indemnity Adjustment

Registered farmers to Philippine Crop Insurance corporation (PCIC) from barangay Pandan that was affected by Typhoon Jolina were assessed by the adjuster from the PCIC Regional Office. Conducted at Pandan Barangay Hall and assisted by one of the Agricultural Technologist from the MAO's Office and LFT Maribel Antonio. There were 30 Rice farmers were assisted to be able to claim their calamity insurance.





E. Gender and Development Program Training on Vegetable Farming for Women

This office conducted Training on Vegetable Farming for Women and funded under the Gender and Development Program of this municipality worth Php248,762.00, last October 4-15, 2021 to two clustered barangay's Danao Norte and Magsaysay. For Danao Norte Cluster it was participated with 44 women and all were 4P's beneficiaries. For Magsaysay Cluster it was participated with 47 women members of Philippine Women's League Romblon (PWLR) Magsaysay Chapter.

IV - FISHERIES

A. COASTAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

The office of the Municipal Agriculturist together with Bantay Dagat conducted installation of bouy/marker at Puro Island Fish Sanctuary and Sabang Cove Fishery Management Area. Supervision, monitoring, evaluation and surveillance were conducted in the area to prevent encroachment of illegal fishers.

B. LIVELIHOD ASSISTANCE

a. Aquaculture

The Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) thru the Office of Municipal Agriculturist turned-over 2 unit of seaweeds nursery to Magsaysay Seaweed Farmers and Fishers Association and Guinbirayan Tabugon Seaweed Farming and Fishing Association located at Puro Island last November 2021. A total of 200 seaweed farmers directly benefit under this project.

A total of 400 seaweeds farmers directly benefit under this project.
