Mandate: The Office of the MENRO is mandated to ensure the implementation of environmental protection services of the Municipality by being the lead agency incharge in developing plans and strategies to conserve, preserve and protect the environment and natural resources of Santa Fe.

Vision: Empowered citizenry in protecting our environment, centered in conserving our natural resources, for a clean, safe and healthy place to live in.

1. Managed the solid waste collection, segregation and final disposal of the two urban Barangays (Poblacion & Guinbirayan), Magsaysay and Pandan, and other Barangays as requested.





2. Shredded over 50 sacks of plastic bottles and over 20 sacks of glass bottles which reduced its waste volume by 80%. Shredded bottles were mixed in making hollow blocks and road concreting.





3. Supervised and implemented the Safe Closure and Rehabilitation Plan of the existing municipal dumpsite as required by the DENR-EMB in compliance to R.A. 9003.







4. Conducted various coastal cleanup activities and removal of Crown-of-Thorns Starfish (COTS), a type of starfish which is very destructive to the coral reefs in partnership with Municipal Agriculture Office.











5. Rescued endangered species (Philippine Forest Turtle) At Sitio Tipolo, Poblacion with the Philippine Coast Guard and MDRRMO with proper referral to the DENR.







6. Conducted Joint Meeting and Public Consultation with the MDRRMO for effective maintenance of cleanliness of coastal areas and shorelines as well as the Solid Waste Management and the integration of COVID-19 Waste Management Plan







7. Spearheaded the Tree Planting Activity with the participation of Government Officials, Employees, NGAs, and others during the Arbor Day.



8. Posted informative tarpaulins and distribution of IEC Materials (Leaflets)







9. Repair and rehabilitation of the old Material Recovery Facility (MRF) Building.


