BIDDINGS**

CONSTRUCTION OF SLAUGHTERHOUSE - PHASE III

In view of the two (2) failed biddings, the Bids and Awards Committee of the Municipal Government of Santa Fe, Romblon invite PhilGEPS registered suppliers to participate in the Negotiation for the project, "**Construction of Slaughterhouse – Phase III**" in accordance with Section 53.1 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act". The Approved Budget for the Contract is **One Million Four Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Pesos & 82/100 (P 1,499,999.82)**.

Opening of bid proposals shall be on **July 29, 2024, 1:30 in the afternoon** at the **Office of the Bids and Awards Committee, Municipal Hall, Poblacion, Santa Fe, Romblon**.

Interested suppliers may submit their bids on or before July 29, 2024, 1:30 in the afternoon at the Office of the Bids and Awards Committee together with the following eligibility documents:

I. TECHNICAL COMPONENT ENVELOPE:

- (a) Valid PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (Platinum Membership) (all pages) in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of the IRR;
- (b) Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid; **and**
- (c) Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid, except under conditions provided under the rules; **and**
- (d) Special PCAB License in case of Joint Ventures **and** registration for the type and cost of the contract to be bid; **and**
- (e) Original copy of Bid Security. If in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission **or** original copy of Notarized Bid Securing Declaration; **and**
- (f) Project Requirements, which shall include the following:
 - a. Organizational chart for the contract to be bid;
 - b. List of contractor's key personnel to be assigned to the contract to be bid, with their complete qualification and experience data:
 1. Project Manager
 2. Project Engineer
 3. Materials Engineers
 4. Safety Officer
 5. First Aider
 6. Foreman
 - c. List of contractor's major equipment units, which are owned, leased, and/or under purchase agreements, supported by proof of ownership or certification of availability of equipment from the equipment lessor/vendor for the duration of the project, as the case may be; **and**
- (g) Original duly signed Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) **and** if applicable, Original Notarized Secretary's Certificate in case of a corporation, partnership, or cooperative; or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder.
- (h) The prospective bidder's computation of Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC).

II. FINANCIAL COMPONENT ENVELOPE:

- (i) Original of duly signed and accomplished Financial Bid Form; **and**
- (j) Original of duly signed Bid Prices in the Bill of Quantities; **and**

- (k) Duly accomplished Detailed Estimates Form, including a summary sheet indicating the unit prices of construction materials, labor rates and equipment rentals used in coming up with the Bid; **and**
- (l) Cash Flow by Quarter.

III. POST QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Latest Income Tax and Business Tax Return
2. Certificate of Registration issued by the BIR

IV. ADDITIONAL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:

1. Construction Schedule and S-curve
2. Manpower Schedule
3. Construction Methods
4. Equipment Utilization Schedule
5. Construction Safety and Health Program Approved by the DOLE
6. PERT-CPM or other acceptable tools of project scheduling
7. Certificate or Affidavit of Site Inspection
8. Contractor's All Risk Insurance (CARI)
9. Authority of the Signing Official

The Municipal Government of Santa Fe, Romblon reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
